BDASC ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

BDASC sets aside funds each year generously donated with the express purpose of providing financial support for college scholarships. To be considered, an applicant must: 1. Be a resident of South Carolina; 2. Be enrolled or accepted at an accredited educational institution, including accredited colleges, universities, technical and vocational schools; 3. Have a diagnosis of a bleeding disorder, or be a dependent
