Sourcing research and considering ideas from James Clear's bestselling book Atomic Habits, this year's program will look at connecting and creating community with others, identifying the current habits and systems we use and how that informs who we are, considering the difference between a "goal" and a "system", building helpful systems to become the people we want to be, and reflecting on ways to maintain those systems as we go out into the real world. We will explore these ideas using games and community building activities that will have participants on their feet and interacting with each other in fun and memorable ways.
