## Eligibility

- **Teens, Ages 13-18**
  - 18-year-olds will attend as leaders-in-training (LIT) and work side by side with counselors and staff for leadership/counselor development
- Diagnosed with an inheritable bleeding disorder or a sibling.
- **Must be patients of Prisma Health HTC and/or members of the BDASC.**
