Articles and advertising materials should be submitted approximately **six weeks prior to publication** to allow for layout, editing, and proofreading.

## Advertising Opportunities

All advertisements will be formatted to fit within the newsletter's layout. While BDASC adheres to accepted industry standards, we reserve the right to reject any advertisement deemed inconsistent with our mission or values.

### Rates per issue:

- **1/8 Page (or ½-page banner):** \$400
- **¼ Page:** \$550
- **½ Page:** \$800
  - Two half-page ads may be purchased per issue (\$1,600 total)
  - Annual package (four issues): \$3,000 (includes \$200 annual discount)
- **Full Page:** \$1,550
  - Annual package (four issues): \$6,000 (includes \$200 annual discount)
